CSIA Atlantic Region Member Appreciation Awards

The CSIA Atlantic Region Member Appreciation Awards are intended to recognize and celebrate Members of the Atlantic Region who have shown outstanding qualities in ski instructing and for the ski industry in Atlantic Canada.

The Member Appreciation Awards will be recognized annually in the fall, usually in conjunction with the Hall of Fame ceremony and annual Members' Regional Convention.

There are five areas of recognition, and four areas of awards. These awards are given in conjunction with activities in the past ski season.

Award of Merit

One candidate from each Snow School in the Region will be considered for final selection. The successful candidate from amongst these nominations will receive a \$500 bursary toward CSIA programming for the upcoming season. These nominees excel in areas that reflect and mold the definition of an outstanding Ski Instructor. Some examples may include outstanding reliability, has the ability to see where help is needed and assists without being asked, is outstanding or good with clients or brings in repeat business, participates in events, reaches out to assist the public (assists carrying equipment or helping those who have fallen), and consistently participates in staff training. Any Member in good standing can nominate another within the Region. Each nomination requires two additional supporting Member signatures.

Outstanding Service Award

Given to an exceptional volunteer in the Region. The Atlantic Board of Directors award this category.

Safety Award

Snow School Directors nominate these individuals. These individuals go beyond in the area of safe teaching practice and the award is designed to recognize individuals in the ski instructing community who have made an important contribution to promote safety, and/or have acted at a level above and beyond that which is normally expected of the Instructor. When nominating for this award, describe the safety activity, incident or program, and the impact of this activity.

Course Conductor of the Year

An Atlantic Course Conductor who, through their actions, have made significant and positive impact on the quality of education as it pertains to Ski Instructors in the Atlantic Region. This individual can be nominated by any Member in the Region with two additional supporting Member signatures.

Honorarium

At the induction ceremony for Atlantic Hall of Fame and Member Appreciation Awards, an honorarium will be given for any Members that have passed away in the previous year.

Eligibilities

Nominators must be current Members in good standing of the CSIA Atlantic Region.

<u>Nominees</u> must be current Members in good standing of the CSIA Atlantic, unless otherwise indicated in the category. A Nominee may be considered in any of the four categories of awards, however, may not be considered in multiple categories concurrently unless the nominations originate from different Members.

The Atlantic Hall of Fame/Awards Committee will screen all nominations as to the legitimacy of the nomination. Their decision should be based on eligibility criteria and whether the achievements or contributions meet the accepted standards required for the award.

Nominations should be free from conflict of interest or perceived conflict of interest situations.

The successful nominees will receive a distinction award, and invitation to the award ceremony (meal included).

Nomination deadline: All 2023 nominations must reach the committee by November 17th, 2023.
