

CSIA NATIONAL HALL OF FAME

The Canadian Ski Instructors' Alliance (CSIA) National Hall of Fame is dedicated to preserving the history of the organization, encouraging the development of young instructors, and enshrining CSIA members who have made a significant contribution to the growth and well-being of the CSIA on a National scale and to the sport of skiing and ski teaching.

The CSIA National Hall of Fame has 4 categories to recognize specific areas of contribution.

Founders

This category is intended to honour those who had a significant role in shaping the CSIA during the early years of our association.

Builders

This category recognizes those who have clearly made a positive contribution to the development of the CSIA either from a National or International perspective.

Inspirational Leader

This category honours and awards those individuals who have demonstrated remarkable leadership skills. They are also perceived as role models thanks to their talent; and most importantly, they have been inspirational mentors to other members and their peers throughout their CSIA career.

Special Contributors

This category is reserved to honour individuals, entities and associations that have made an impact on the ski industry through their dedication to the sport. These honourees may or may not be members of the CSIA. This is a means for the CSIA to acknowledge and recognize a partner in the industry.

Nomination Process

To nominate an individual, please fill out the CSIA Hall of Fame nomination submission form that appears below. **Nomination Deadline:** Please submit your nomination by **June 15, 2024**, by email to hof-tdlr@snowpro.com

In addition to nominations coming from the membership at large, the Hall of Fame Committee may also nominate and select worthy members for consideration.

The Induction Ceremony of the selected nominees for the Founders, Builders, Contributors, or Inspirational Leader categories is held annually in the fall during the annual Eastern and Western member events.

The CSIA National Hall of Fame Committee will review and consider all nominations to determine who the successful candidates will be. Please note that all nominations remain active for a period of five (5) years. If a nomination is not selected for this year, it will be eligible for another four (4) years.

With your help, deserving individuals will receive the recognition they have earned through perseverance and dedication to the betterment of the CSIA on a national basis.

The selected candidate(s) names will be submitted to the National Board of Directors for final approval to make a nomination official.
