Prerequisites:

- 14 years of age on the first day of the Course
- Confident parallel skiing on Intermediate terrain
- Some experience in the Snow Park environment is an asset

Description:

The Snow Park Certification Course provides training for your own riding as well as teaching park skills to children and adults by exploring the following:

- How to teach safely in the age of COVID-19
- Collaborative Teaching Approaches
- Switch skiing, boxes, rails, basic airs, grabs and spins
- CSIA Technical Concepts
- Park etiquette and safety awareness
- Guest Service and Communication Skills

Candidates will receive coaching on their skiing, as well as feedback on their teaching skills, with the goal of reaching the Snow Park Certification standard in both of these areas. They will also receive suggestions and strategies for long-term development.

The Snow Park Certification qualifies as a prerequisite for registration to the CSIA Level 2 Program.
