A proven technique to improve your own understanding of a subject is to teach others and that is exactly what the Trainer Designation Program will give you an opportunity to do. Participants will learn how to model a clear and concise lesson approach and will be shown how to pass on knowledge and experience to 'new' Ski Instructors who are at the beginning of their development journey.

As a Trainer, an ability to provide a well-structured, interactive and collaborative training opportunity for new Instructors is key for them to gain knowledge and confidence. Candidates will learn how to teach others to create a safe, valuable and memorable experience to the students they encounter. The Trainer Designation is offered in a two-day Trainer Development format and culminates in a one-day Trainer Exam. These components can be taken at various times to fit your schedule and do not have to be taken simultaneously.

Further training includes but not limited to: L1 CC Training, Pro Day Trainer, etc. The Trainer exam can be done before or after the 'further training' that's available.

The Trainer Designation is a prerequisite to apply to the Level 4 Academy and to become an active Level 1 Course Conductor.
